Sermon Application Guide 3/2/25: Kingdom Culture Part 5: Kingdom Ambassadors

Day 1: Understanding Our Identity

- Scripture Reading: Philippians 3:20; Ephesians 2:19
- Reflection: Reflect on what it means to have your citizenship in heaven. How does this new identity as a member of God's household change your perspective on daily life?
- Application: Write down areas in your life where you feel divided loyalties. Pray for clarity and commitment to live fully as a citizen of heaven.

Day 2: Serving One Master

- Scripture Reading: Matthew 6:24
- Reflection: Consider the things in your life that compete with your devotion to God. What are the "idols" that you might be serving alongside God?
- Application: Choose one area where you feel torn between serving God and another "master." Make a plan to prioritize God in that area this week.

Day 3: Living as Ambassadors

- Scripture Reading: John 20:21; 2 Corinthians 5:20
- Reflection: What does it mean to be an ambassador for Christ in your current context (work, home, community)?
- Application: Identify one specific way you can represent God's Kingdom in your daily interactions. This could be through acts of kindness, sharing your faith, or serving others.

Day 4: Following Jesus' Example

- Scripture Reading: John 6:38; John 14:10
- Reflection: Reflect on how Jesus lived as an ambassador of God's Kingdom. How can you emulate His obedience and dedication to the Father's will?
- Application: Spend time in prayer asking God to reveal His will for you today. Commit to following His guidance in one specific area.

Day 5: Overcoming Barriers

- Scripture Reading: Ephesians 5:15-16; Colossians 4:5
- Reflection: What barriers prevent you from living fully as an ambassador for Christ? Consider both internal (fear, doubt) and external (busyness, distractions) obstacles.
- Application: Write down one barrier you will work to overcome this week. Seek accountability from a friend or mentor to help you stay focused on your mission.

Each day, conclude with a prayer asking God for strength, wisdom, and courage to live out your identity as His ambassador.
