

Sermon Devotion and Application Guide May 26-30

Sermon May 25, 2025 Good, Great, Greater Part 4: An Unquenchable Flame

John 14:12-14

Day 1: Embracing the Presence of God

Scripture: John 17:23

- **Devotion:** Reflect on the importance of coming to church with an open heart, ready to encounter God's presence. Consider how the disciples gathered to pray for power from on high and how we, too, can seek to live with the full power of the Holy Spirit.
- **Application:** Spend time in prayer today, asking God to help you approach Him with vulnerability and openness. Commit to honoring and worshiping Him in all His fullness.

Day 2: Understanding Our Identity in Christ

Scripture: Romans 8:14

- **Devotion:** Meditate on the truth that we are sons and daughters of the Most High God. Our identity in Christ empowers us to live out our faith and make a difference in the world.
- **Application:** Write down what it means to you to be a child of God. Reflect on how this identity influences your daily life and decisions. Pray for the Holy Spirit to guide you in living out this identity.

Day 3: Living by the Spirit

Scripture: Galatians 5:22-23

- **Devotion:** Consider the role of the Holy Spirit in Jesus' ministry and how we, too, have access to the same Spirit. Reflect on the fruits of the Spirit and how they manifest in your life.
- **Application:** Identify one fruit of the Spirit you want to cultivate more in your life. Pray for the Holy Spirit to help you grow in this area and look for opportunities to practice it throughout the day.

Day 4: Building on the Foundation of Christ

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 3:10-15

- **Devotion:** Reflect on the importance of building your life on the foundation of Jesus Christ. Consider how your actions and choices contribute to the spiritual fruit that remains.
- **Application:** Evaluate the "materials" you are using to build your life. Are they aligned with the teachings of Christ? Make a plan to invest in activities that build up your faith and the faith of others.

Day 5: Doing Greater Things

Scripture: Revelation 3:5-6

- **Devotion:** Reflect on the call to do greater things through the power of the Holy Spirit. Consider the steps necessary to live a life of truthfulness, confession, repentance, and submission to God.
- **Application:** Spend time in self-examination and prayer. Confess any areas where you need to repent and ask God for the strength to submit to His will. Commit to living a life that pleases the Lord and seeks to do greater things for His Kingdom.

Each day, take time to journal your thoughts and prayers, and ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in applying these truths to your life.
